As mentioned in the Chair's Report, through the A/U Committee, we were able to finalize revisions to the Central Pro-D fund application process. We hope that these changes will make the Central Pro-D funds more accessible to members.

This year the university brought several requests for exclusions to the A/U Committee. These requests included both new and existing positions. Requests are reviewed on their merit and this year resulted in one being accepted, one being designated as a PEA position and one still unresolved.

The A/U Committee is in the process of acting on [LOU #8 Re: Article 17](#) to review the administration of paid sick leave in relation to the administration of Long Term Disability.

While we have no specific language in our collective agreement pertaining to child care we did use A/U as our venue to share our member's input on the proposed changes to the on-campus child care centre.
