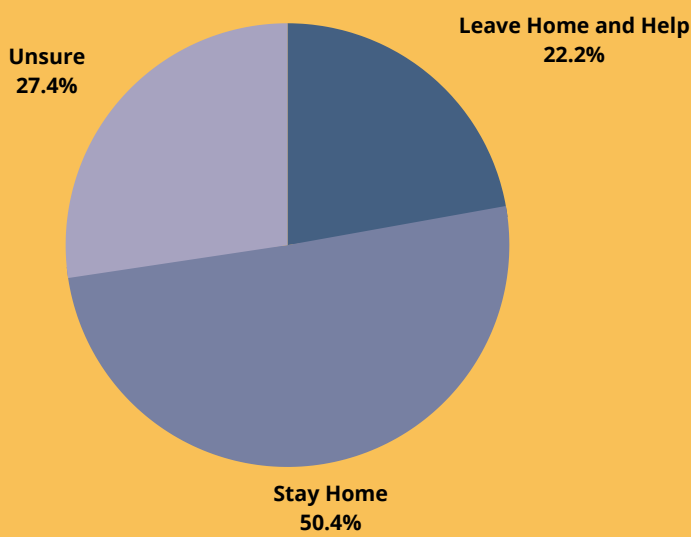


Prosocial Behaviours

Duty to Help Others

Proportion of participants' reported sense of prosocial duty during COVID-19:

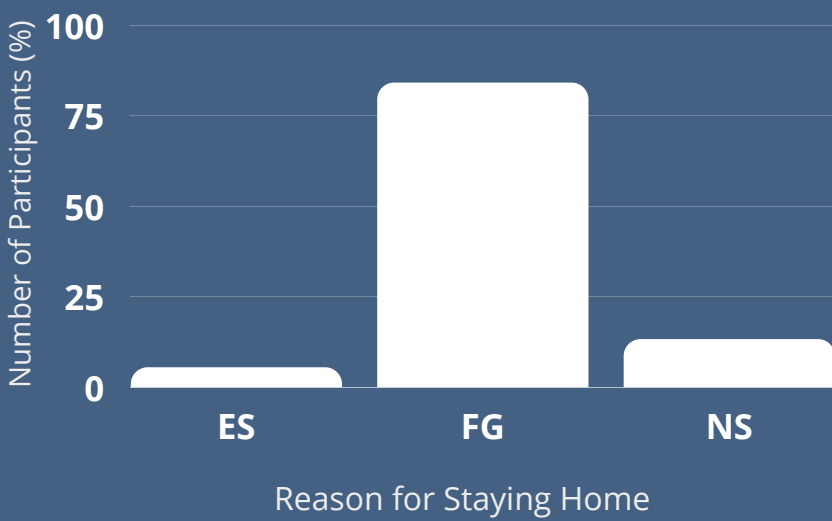


Demographic differences:

- Health care workers were more than twice as likely to report a **duty to leave home and help**, when compared to other professions.
- Men were more likely to report a **duty to leave home to help** during COVID-19, when compared to women.

Staying Home

Proportion of Reported Reasons Among Those with a Duty to Stay Home

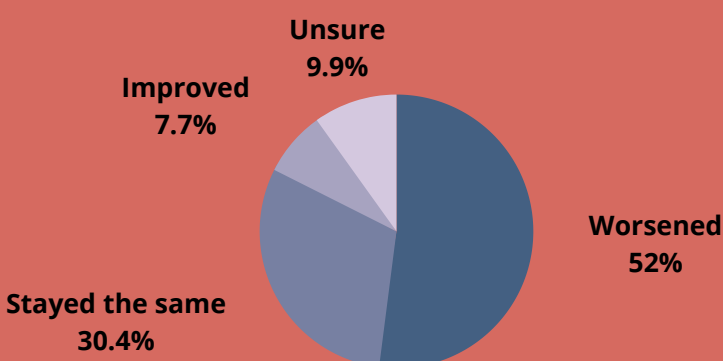


Legend
