

Canadians' Attitudes Towards Receiving the COVID-19 Vaccine

About 25% of Canadians endorse some degree of vaccine

Estimates
suggest upwards

population needs

immunity

About 37% of the population may remain unvaccinated due to vaccine hesitancy or ineligibility to receive the vaccine (such as those aged 12 and younger)

Reasons for Vaccine Hesitancy

"I am not comfortable receiving a vaccine that is less than one year old. I understand that the vaccine has supposedly undergone all the right tests to assure effectiveness, but I trust the government less now than I ever have and believe much of the pandemic has been used for political and capital gain."

"I want to wait to see side effects, effectiveness, and if there are any problems with it."

"Not convinced of effectiveness. Really concerned with side effects and long term effects of a vaccine that was developed so quickly."
