

COVID-19 VACCINE HESITANCY IN CANADA

All data was collected from September-December of 2021




Not Vaccinated...

- Planned to get Vaccinated
- Admitted to being hesitant 35.6%
- Did not want to be Vaccinated
- Could Not Be Vaccinated for Medical Reasons



Likelihood of Receiving a Booster Vaccine



Canada's Chief Medical Advisor, Dr. Supriya Sharma noted that 85-90% of the entire Canadian population needs to be vaccinated, and maintain their immunity through booster shots, to achieve herd immunity against COVID-19

- Vaccine effectiveness against COVID-19 decreases after 4-6 months, to a point that is no longer considered acceptable protection
- Given that 10% of the population remains unvaccinated, all vaccinated people need to receive their booster shot to maintain herd immunity against COVID-19
