### Fall 2021 First Year Representative Election - Nomination Procedure

As a UVic Engineering Undergraduate student, you are a Regular member of the Engineering Students' Society!

Any Regular member of the Engineering Students' Society may nominate themselves. Regular members who wish to nominate themselves must submit the ESS Nomination Form, as found on the following page, to the Vice President Internal (Alexandra Boucher-Carter) via email to [essvpinternal@engr.uvic.ca](mailto:essvpinternal@engr.uvic.ca) in either .pdf or .docx format before the end of the nomination period (**by Friday, September 24th**).

Should the individual choose to submit a photograph of themselves, they should attach the photograph to the same email in which they submit their Nomination Form.

For the Nomination Form to be valid, the individual must submit it from their primary UVic email. This will allow the Vice President Internal (VPI) to validate that the individual is a Regular member of the ESS.
