

- Held in Toronto from January 27 29, 2023
- I invited Kath (current co-leader of LTD) but i asked them like 5m before the meeting started so i can't count on them being here
- o Pre-reg closes on the 21st
 - This is very soon, we need to decide if we want to send delegates or not imminently
 - I can ask for an extension but we cant count on that
 - I am very sorry about the short notice, but i just found out about it yesterday!
- LTD does not have any plans for it yet which is concerning considering the close date
- According to the conference resources, either the local EQ chapter (in our case LTD) or the ESS should send delegates.
 - -need to make a decision fairly quickly if we want to send people -main points:
 - -delegate fee (\$150-200 / person) (1-3 delegates), travel too isn't included
 - -since conference similar to CDE timing is too tight, look into this next year though (the onus probably falls on the local LTD chapters)
 - -other option is to ask for an extension, is it worth it? result: yes
 - Policy should be written based on our decision abt this

VP Finance

- Our account current has about \$60,000 in it, with clubs funding a big thing that will eat into it
- Please don't agree to pay people on the ESS's behalf without getting it approved first (obviously some stuff is pre-approved but that's like normal things, not fun new one offs)
- We're fine, but ngl I kinda want us to be careful with spending
 -student fees will be decreasing, need to stop relying on covid carryover
- Discussion Points
 - Makerspace and stuff, how much are we willing to put up for it? There was talk/request of \$15,000, as sorta an upper limit. This is a lot, but probably doable. However, a big question I have is how many student fees we will get with lower enrollment. A lower amount may be possible. I will not commit us to this without asking a few more times, this is all early planning

"Heyo Cord! I'm working on getting UVSS funding for a makerspace, and I just wanted to run a few questions by you. When I discussed this with Abdul, the idea that he floated was the ESS could match UVSS funding of around 15k, as well as work with the faculty to get the space needed and maybe some extra funding.

We had a semi-committeent of 15k from the former UVSS finops director, but then he resigned and Abdul pissed everyone off with his ultimatum, so it's now up in the air. Before I have another discussion with our new finops director, I was wondering if you could give a more concrete idea of what the ESS would be able to contribute (if y'all feel like it.) Abdul proposed matching the 15k, getting the space in ELW near Petch (the one currently under renovation), and leaving the makerspace in the hands of the ESS, with some provision of continuing financial support from the UVSS. Is this doable on behalf of the ESS? Maybe we can meet sometime to figure out what would work providing it works with you" - Julien Edwards UVSS DAL

- -students dont want their fees to go up, especially if they dont think they will make use of it
- -determine whos ownership the makerspace will fall under, ESS or UVSS
- -additionally, this 15k is just an estimate and details must be figured out before commitment
- -potentially sponsors (need advertising in the space), faculty, or UVSS
- -makerspace more important than the branding of it (Canadian Petroleum Alliance

Makerspace), additionally must check if the demand is actually there

- -potentially campaign to try and get students to make a referendum for ESS
- -however, running a makerspace requires alot of work (VP Maker position)
- -potentially make a coop position for the director of the makerspace
- -issue: makerspace can require alot of training to be safe
- -more details should be in supplementary meetings
- -for now: what role fits best with it?
- -VP Corporate \rightarrow "Professional Outreach" and has comparatively lighter duties compared to other positions
- -RESPONSE: We talked about it, lets meet and discuss details further
