- Jan 10: Advertising starts
- Jan 13: Pre-Reg due (must be able to afford the amount of delegates)
- Jan 16: Confirming number of delegates
- Jan 18: Applications Close
- Jan 19: Delegates shortlisted, interviews scheduled (THIS IS ALSO WHEN WEC STARTS)
- Jan 23: Interviews Start?
- Jan 24: Delegates finalized?
- Jan 25: Delegate registration due (late reg is \$50)
- Jan 27: Invoice sent for delegates
- Feb 23: Conference
 - Note that WEC happens from the 19th-22nd, this makes things very difficult as this is the period when i WOULD have been interviewing people
 - Partially this is on me for not looking at my availability for interviews but also WEC ends
 3 days before the registration deadline and that is a nightmare no matter what
 - At minimum, delegate shortlisting and interview scheduling will have to be done at WEC
 - Interviews will have to be done during WEC online as well if we want more than one day for registration, which we DO want
 - I have asked the CSE chair for a 1- or 2-day extension for the registration deadline. IF WE GET THIS then it will make things INFINITELY easier as we will have at least 2 days for registration and at least 2 days for interviewing.

 - Inclusive washrooms

 - Must be able to reach venue
 - Non-alcohol based events
 - Mindfulness time
 - Time allocated for breaks

 - IMO the accessibility list is really good and we should look into adapting
 a version of it for our own events! Our current policy specifies that we
 must advertise if events have gender inclusive bathrooms and are
 wheelchair accessible but that is it

 - Venue transportation
 - Walking distance
 - Dietary restrictions
