

- The exam bank has started to become unwieldy. Lots of exams have been scanned, and they're easier to sort through when you can search the name of the class in a digital folder.
 - I have seen people look for exams, and literally give up on a service we're meant to provide, and that's disheartening.
 - I want to collaborate with Allen to get all the exams digitized and scanned, but more than that I think we can get rid of the old paper exams to free up space in the lounge. Thoughts?

- Makerspace
 - We have multiple funding options, depending on how long we can get to pay off the 450k
 - Let's hope CSC students join us
 - If not we're definitely screwed
 - Use a referendum to take 90% out of what we get from CINKANT and pay it off in 7 years
 - Money coming out will be roughly the same
 - Timespan of 5-8 years, ranging from 100% of scrape off to 25% of scrape off, respectively
 - Stick to the 7 year plan then only take out 50%
 - Ask for one more year we only need to take out 25%
