

- Account is unfrozen, cheques are now available and can be cashed
  - Ensure name on check in name on persons ID (onecard etc.)
  - Great!
  - Square funds (approx \$1500) will be transferred on Wednesday
  - Business as usual
- Please stop complaining about the lack of cutlery and dairy
  - We have spent about 90% of our coffee/slushie budget
    - That means we have about \$70 left
    - One bag of coffee costs \$65 and lasts about two weeks
    - We might also have an outstanding payment with fernwood coffee
    - This is clearly an issue considering we're less than half the way through the term
    - To fix this, we're temporarily not buying milk and cutlery
      - When I do the midterm budget review later this week I will *try* and find the money to make it happen again
    - I received 3 phone calls on Sunday from people unhappy that we're not buying milk and cutlery anymore
      - Don't spam call me over the weekend unless it's for urgent matters
    - As a general rule, when I make a decision, take a look at the budget before complaining to me. It's really been frustrating with the constant complaints, I'm doing my job properly to make sure that the ESS isn't consistently in the red
