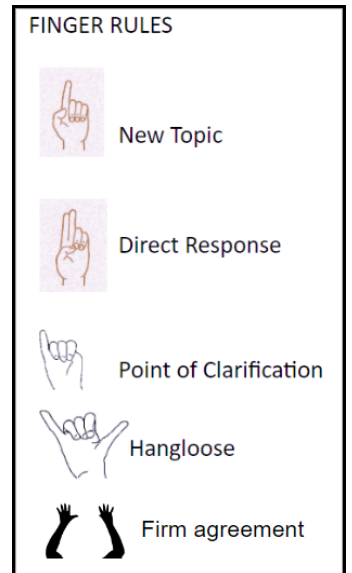

Turning ideas into actions

 - For posters we don't need it. However designing merch using canva/etc sucks and that's where adobe illustrator could come in handy
 - In the near future I want to look into free open source graphics tools for our graphics coordinators and merch designers to use, they are sometimes a bit harder to learn than Adobe because there aren't as many tutorials out there but I am willing to write tutorials/documentation for them.

 - Assesses overall store finances
 - Operating at a profit when sale value of current stock is included
 - Operating at a loss when only weighing expenses and income
 - This is to be expected
 - Trying to figure out how often a report should be completed
 - Probably once in the middle of each term and once at the end of each term?
 - Every two months
- Coffee/Slushie budget is looking bad
 - Have spent \$461.07 out of \$600.00
 - \$202.89 of that was slushie mix
 - The cost of the slushie mix is what we expected
 - Too much was used last friday
 - Upcoming weeks we have to be more stingy
 - [Will be discussing with Alen who has “slushie” office hours](#)
 - If we run out we’re not buying anymore until next term or until a unicorn shows up and gives us a bag of free money
 - The latter is not happening
 - Will be prioritizing coffee in the budget since it’s a more universally used service
 - Should have enough money left for coffee
 - May also have to cut back on paper plates and cutlery, much to my own personal disappointment :(
- New budget spreadsheet! Yay!

 - Has all sorts of bells and whistles
 - Main points:
 - Tracks uncashed cheques to give a current and minimum net
 - Minimum net = actual net - value of uncashed cheques
 - Automatically updates with ledger as cheques are issued (once a week)
