

Midterm budget review

- Midterm budget review is done:
  - **Hidterm Budget Review Summer 2023**
  - There have been several adjustments to the budget in order to reflect rising costs for certain parts of the budget
  - Please reference this sheet when budgeting for items in line items
    - Notable things:
      - Changes in events (EEE budget increased, climbing night canceled)
      - Changes in store income (Bringing in more money then expected, making a few hundred dollars)
      - Changes in pre-ordered merch (Gotten rid of it in budget sheet as it is not happening this term)
      - Changes in coffee/slushie budget (Added \$350 to coffee/slushie budget)
      - Please look through and make sure you are within budget for anything you are responsible for. (the store is an exception as it makes money)
  - We're sinking into our \$1000 surplus (aren't we glad we had that)
    - About a third of the way through
  - No further changes will be made to the budget (e.g. no new events, being reasonable with slushies, etc.) FINAL
- Referendum Updates

- We (Jason) made a cost tracking sheet to make sure we aren't losing tons of money on every item
  - We're making some profit from capitalizing on sales
  - Losing money on monster and red bull
  - Even without earnings from items on sales, we are making a small profit
- (On our end) We've been checking our own receipts in Costco to make sure there aren't any sales errors
- In the future make menu for store items (low priority)
  - Helps as some of the stickers on the drawers are out of date
- Question: Are we good with how the store is currently run (what we buy, how much, possibly rotating items)?
  - It would not be wise to expand it, we are already doing \$800 Costco runs
  - People are wanting different selections for drinks (rotating list)
