Stable Individual Differences: Anthropomorphism as an enduring trait.	Factor Analysis: Validating connection and safety as stable factors.
Sociality Motivation: Seeking humanlike connection to fulfill social needs.	Kinship: Feeling the robot is "like me" or part of the self (Item 1).
Effectance Motivation: Anthropomorphizing to increase predictability.	Trust Safety: Relying on the robot's consistent, unvarying nature (Item 8).
Attributing Mind: Perceiving intentions, emotions, and consciousness.	Affective Sensing: Believing the robot can "tell what I am feeling" (Item 5).
