




The approximate number of classes or labs that I did not attend




Relative to other courses I have taken at UVic, the workload in this course was



The approximate number of hours per week I spent studying for this course outside of class time:



Comments

- -I found that much of the material in this course was repetition from previous courses and the small amount of new material could easily be integrated and combined with other courses.
- I would say this course over very little new material

I think having the angst of the 45% paper at the end was overwhelming but she helped guide us and provide us with as much support as possible to make it doable/bearable.

I wish every section had the opportunity to do the immunization modules worth 20% of the course grade because my section did not and I had a 45% paper where others only had a paper worth 25% and why? Because I was randomly put in a class where the instructor had academic freedom.

Very well done course! Maybe make the outlines worth a bit of a percent like 15% towards the term paper so that it takes some weight off the final term paper submission?

I enjoyed this course

I think dividing the workload more would be helpful...having a paper worth 45% is just a little stressful for then end of term.

I think having more of a variety with assignments would be great for enhancing the learning experience. Writing discussion posts each week is very repetitive, and not easy to learn from if your group is not understanding the content. Although, getting to discuss content as a group on our own time was helpful.

Having the weekly group assignments worth more than the paper that is due at the end of the semester. Puts a lot of pressure on one assignment and increases student anxiety. Especially when 3 assignments are due on the same day.

Do not change anything. This class was perfect!

This course was the only one that didn't stress me out. This is the right way to introduce group work to cohort of students who haven't done group work in over a year. Expectations were very clear and assignments were manageable yet very effective in consolidating my learning and broadening my interest in community health. As someone with learning difficulties, it's hard to maintain interest in a course but it was so easy with N350, 10/10.

Personally, I think the assignments and weight of each could be changed. The weekly discussion posts were fine, but the end paper that was worth 45% of the grade was quite stressful.

Although I understand instructors have academic freedom to teach, it is extremely unfair that different sections have different assignments. I think that it is much more equitable to have similar assignments across all sections. The fact that one section did not have a term paper – disadvantages those of us that did. The other section has more time to spend on other end–of–term papers for other courses. In all other courses – similar assignments if not the same assignments were required across all sections, I do not understand why it was different for this course.
